If a title is not available in our collection, we may purchase it or send out an interlibrary loan request to other New Hampshire libraries. Another way we assure that patrons get a title they want is through our Bestseller Reserve Service. When a book becomes part of our collection and has been requested by someone, we will contact them by phone to notify them that the book is in and is being held for them to pick up at the Reserve Desk.

Always remember to call the library during inclement weather to make sure we are open. You can always get storm information by listening to FM radio station WZID or watch local cable station 17.

Our Local History Collection, which includes Guide Books to Forest Hill Cemetery and Maps to Early Settler's Section, is available for genealogy research.

The Parents' Shelf of Books contains reading material dealing with sensitive issues.
